Debit Card Protection Tips

- When selecting a PIN, avoid numbers and letters that relate to your personal information.
- Keep your card in a safe place to avoid damage or theft.
- If you're unsure if your card is lost, you may also freeze your debit card on the app and if located you may unfreeze it.
- Immediately report a lost or stolen card to Trans Texas
or after hours—800-523-4175.
- To help guard against fraud, keep your ATM receipts until you check them against your monthly statement.

Inactive/Dormant Accounts

Texas requires that the Credit Union establishes contact with our members every 3 years to keep accounts active. After 3 years of no activity on the account or contact with our members, accounts will be considered dormant. We will attempt to contact you by mail and phone, so it is important that you always keep this information updated. If you believe your account may be one of our dormant accounts, please contact Joanna Bryan. Just a simple phone call or a yearly deposit will help keep your account active.

April 15, 2025 is the Deadline for 2024 IRA contributions.

Traditional IRA contributions may be fully or partially deductible, depending on your income, filing status, whether you are covered by a retirement plan at work and whether you receive Social Security Benefits.
